Faculty position in Materials Physics

The Department of Physics at Emory University invites applications and nominations for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in the broad area of Materials Physics, to begin in September 2011. The department has targeted Materials Physics as the area for future expansion, and plans to conduct further hiring in this area, in order to build on, and extend, the current research strengths in experimental molecular biophysics and soft matter physics, and theoretical biological, computational, and statistical physics. Areas of interest include biomaterials, molecular self-assembly, nanomagnetism, photonics, spintronics, and materials for novel energy applications, but applications from all fields of Materials Physics will be considered. Candidates are expected to establish an independent, externally funded research program, and to be committed to excellence in teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels.
